In West and Central Africa it is restricted to fragmented and isolated populations with a declining trajectory. It is regionally extinct in North Africa, southern Europe, and West Asia. In this part of Africa, lion populations are regionally extinct in Lesotho, Djibouti and Eritrea, and threatened by loss of habitat and prey base, killing by local people in retaliation for loss of livestock, and in several countries also by trophy hunting.

Historically lions occurred in sub-Saharan Africa as well as from northern Africa into southwest Asia and Europe. However only a remnant population remains in India and the present day populations only occur in sub-Saharan Africa.

The IUCN declares the region of South Africa lions will be categorized as Least Concern, and the Indian Asiatic lion population is Endangered, *Panthera leo leo* (Bauer et al. 2016). The cause of lion population decline is indiscriminate killing in defense of humans and livestock, habitat loss, and prey depletion in current home ranges.

The lion is a predatory carnivore - they hunt and kill other animals for food. The lionesses (female) do most of the hunting for the pride. As they are more effective hunters, as they are smaller, swifter, and more agile than the males. However, lions usually hunt in coordinated groups and stalk their chosen prey.
