This technique is predominantly used in parasitology laboratories. By exploiting the density of the parasites, particularly eggs, it allows the parasites to float to the top of a dense solution (final specific gravity of about 1.20) and can then be skimmed from the top of the tube. The most

commonly used reagent is zinc sulphate. Operculated eggs as well as schistosoma and infertile Ascaris eggs are not easily recovered by this method.

The disadvantages of most flotation techniques are that the walls of eggs and cysts will often collapse, thus hindering identification. Also, some parasite eggs do not float. Sedimentation techniques use solutions of lower specific gravity than the parasitic organisms, thus concentrating the latter in the sediment. Sedimentation techniques are recommended for general diagnostic laboratories because they are easier to perform and less prone to technical errors.
