Mainline U-Boot also use syslinux/extlinux as payload. You need to install the boot configuration file extlinux.conf in an ext2/3/4 partition of SD card and U-Boot will find and execute it. This is conceptually identical to creating a GRUB configuration file on a desktop PC. Example extlinux.conf:
